

Camp Activities

A wide variety of stimulating and challenging activities are planned to prepare young people for the ever-changing world they must face.

Outdoor activities for both boys and girls include canoeing, nature hikes, courses in organized games, and gun safety. Water safety



will be taught in the swimming and canoeing sessions. National Rifle Association awards can be earned in the riflery classes. Archery is taught and awarded according to the standards of the National Archery Association.

Activities for our boys feature classes in woodlore, instinct shooting, and woodworking. Campers may also participate in "Tool Time," an activity in which they learn how to use a variety of tools in everyday settings.



Tailored especially for our girls are sessions in personal grooming and social graces which are designed to build self-esteem and confidence. Arts and crafts, music classes, life skills, and drama allow for full feminine expression.

Other activities, including Bible sharing times, hayrides, campfires, singing, and lively night activities, fill a busy schedule for



seven days and seven nights of fun and fellowship. Four meals a day prepared by The Gospel's fine kitchen staff always highlight the day. The counseling and instructing staffs are composed of concerned Christian women and men who are



interested in seeing young people realize their full God-given potential. Because safety and security for the campers is of utmost importance to us, each staff member has been thoroughly trained prior to camp in order to ensure a safe camping experience with the highest quality of leadership.

Facilities

Situated on 87 acres of rolling pine covered hills in North Central Louisiana, The Gospel Camp calls Ruston home. The picturesque lake boasts of its own island with foot bridges linking the more populated part of the property with the wildlife preserve in the outback. Fully air conditioned and heated, the dorm style sleeping quarters insure year round living comfort. The spacious patio/dining hall overlooks the shimmering lake where wild waterfowl glide in and out to make their home.



Complete with covered shooting stations, the archery range insures the proper distances to test skills of each bowman. The riflery range building offers ten shooting stations for safe, accurate riflery instruction. Swings, see-saws, and other playground equipment promise hours of fun for younger ones.

The focal point of the water activities is the sweeping 200-foot water slide from which campers splash into the lake. The canoe course around the island channel offers a challenging course to be navigated. Large playing fields for softball, soccer, and other group activities offer plenty of room for lively campers, while the large pavilion provides a shady area for basketball, ping pong, foos ball, and more.
